Cancer, diabetes, HIV/AIDS and infectious diseases are just some of the topics to be covered by Texas Tech University HSC at El Paso faculty and resident physicians and University of Texas at El Paso researchers during the 1st Annual TTUHSC at El Paso Research Day, Friday, April 27.
