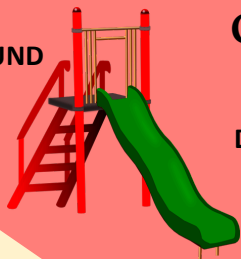

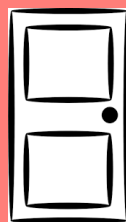
Over 3 million people in the US are positive for COVID-19. The number of children infected with COVID-19 is increasing daily.

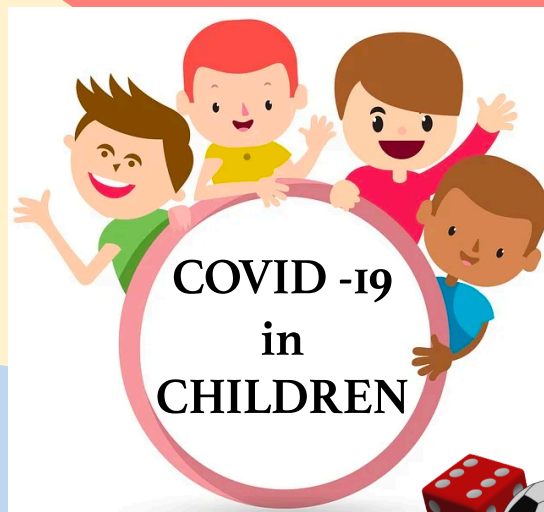
WHAT ARE SOME COVID-19 SYMPTOMS CHILDREN CAN HAVE?

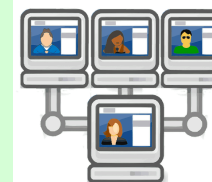
DISINFECT SURFACES
