CONFERENCE OVERVIEW AND TARGET AUDIENCE

- Apply new methods in the diagnosis and treatment of spine, pelvic, leg, and hip trauma
- Discuss the challenges related to brain death, organ failure, and the delivery of had news
- Use tools and strategies to reduce incidents of infection, pneumonia, and associated conditions related to traumaticinjury
- Describe the development of emergency preparedness from a historical perspective and identify current response systems
