1. The first author of the abstract must have actively participated in the research project.
2. A presenter may submit a maximum of two abstracts.
3. The abstract should contain
 - A short and descriptive title
 - A concise statement about the problem under investigation or the hypothesis to be tested
 - A concise statement about the experimental method used
 - The essential results obtained (specific findings must be included; broad generalizations or the promise "to be completed" are not acceptable) in summary form
 - Conclusions
4. Poster abstracts will be accepted on the basis of the merit of the data presented in the abstract. ***Incomplete or improperly executed abstracts will be rejected.*** Submission of an abstract does not guarantee acceptance for presentation at the meeting. The decision of the Program and Planning Committee regarding accepted and rejected abstracts is final.
