OVERVIEW AND TARGET AUDIENCE

Addressing maternal and child health issues in the El Paso area is a priority in order to improve health status in the next generation. This conference is designed for family and general practice physicians, OB/GYN's, pediatricians, neonatologists, residents, physician extenders, nurses, early intervention specialists, physical and occupational therapists, social workers, and other interested healthcare professionals. This will increase practitioner knowledge, competence, and skills in the delivery of maternal and child healthcare.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Identify legal and ethical obligations of healthcare professionals when treating patients during the perinatal period and recognize the importance of a trans-cultural and multi disciplinary approach to healthcare. 2. Discuss the delivery of quality healthcare under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act. 3. Evaluate high-risk pregnancies, treat and manage the care of infants with neurodevelopmental problems, and be able to evaluate and manage the dysmorphic child.

4. Provide care that results in improved outcomes of high risk mothers and improved neurodevelopment outcomes of the at-risk infant. 5. Recognize the impact of pre and post natal nutrition on the growing fetus and infant's neuro and ophthalmic development. 6. Explain the importance of individualized neurodevelopmental care in the growing premature infant.
