CHIP Sign Up

A city-wide CHIP Enrollment Day is planned for August 1 at the Memorial Park Gazebo in central El Paso. Centro Salud Familiar La Fe, and the West Texas CHIP Collaborative will be assisting families apply for the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center at El Paso, a member of the collaborative, will be supporting this effort the same day with its own CHIP enrollment from 8 a.m. - 5 p.m., at these locations:

- * Texas Tech Medical Center, 4801 Alberta Ave.
- * Montwood Wellness Center, 11950 Bob Mitchell
- * Child Wellness Center, 12583 Darrington Rd. in Horizon
- * Northeast Family Practice Center, 9849 Kenworthy

Interested families are asked to bring with them proof of income such as the two most recent check stubs, or a copy of their 2005 income tax form. Parents should also bring the following documents for each child applicant: birth certificate, social security number, proof of expenses, (daycare receipts, and if applicable, copies of checks for child support). A parent or guardian must sign the application.

At all the sign-up sites, persons trained by the Health and Human Services Commission (HHS) will be assisting families with the CHIP application. Texas Tech University HSC pediatric social workers will also assist at the Alberta, Montwood and Horizon locations. El Paso First staff will assist with applications at the Northeast Family Practice Center.

Staff from the Austin HHS will be at Memorial Park as well as the Texas Tech Medical Center to provide technical assistance.

At its enrollment peak, CHIP in El Paso had 26,000 children covered under its health insurance plan. Presently, 13,000 children are covered after subsequent changes in CHIP enrollment policies by the HHS Commission. The West Texas CHIP Collaborative, a group of community health organizations, have earmarked the enrollment day as the beginning of a series of activities for the rest of the year that will increase CHIP enrollments and improve the health of El Paso Children.
