don't give, they're suggesting that you give to the organization that can help these individuals. Both departments have launched this meaningful campaign, because the City of El Paso cares. A pamphlet is being mailed to hundreds of homes and businesses in the El Paso area with the reminder, "There's a better way to help!"

Donations given directly to these individuals might lead to substance abuse and encourages panhandling. This literature includes the phone number of the El Paso Coalition for the Homeless where individuals can call to learn alternatives for making monetary donations in El Paso. Furthermore, it is unlawful, dangerous and creates a traffic hazard. It is also a Class "C" misdemeanor for both the donor and the recipient that is punishable up to \$500 plus court costs.

The number to call is 843-2170.

Police say these are the benefits in providing assistance the proper way:

- * Individuals in need will receive the proper referrals when calling
- * Donations/monies will be directed to the proper agencies
- * Individuals will not handle monies but rather receive benefits through specific agencies
- * Eliminates hazardous traffic situations involving individuals in or along our roadways
- * Individuals cannot spend your donations on alcohol or drugs
- * Your donations are tax deductible
