*Don't have to buy name brands; Generic medications, which are much cheaper, can be bought as long as the primary ingredient is the same as that of the name brand.

- Acetaminophen/Tylenol
 - This medication will be needed as well, but it does not have an anti-inflammatory effect. It is secondary to what is needed as far as pain medications go.
