Teethsavers International, Inc. is a nonprofit organization dedicated to educating third world populations on dental hygiene and tooth care. Their mission is to introduce and facilitate the teaching and provision of simple and inexpensive dental care for children. Since its creation nine years ago, the Teethsavers organization has grown into a host of volunteers, contributors, visiting dentists and dental students from all over the world. Teethsavers currently has projects in Gambia, Malawi, Zambia, Uganda, Morocco, Sierra Leone, Nicaragua, and Belize.

Dr. Jack Rudd is the founder and director of Teetsavers International, Inc. He is from Lubbock, TX. He settled in Zambia in 2001 after teaching, treating and evaluating oral health care in Asia and various parts of Africa. For his work in Zambia, Dr. Rudd received the 2007 Award of Distinction in the field of Continuing Dental Education from the Academy of Dentistry International.
