Tuberculosis is developing resistance to almost every drug available, which has led to fears of an epidemic. In South Africa, health authorities have locked up patients diagnosed with XDR-TB in an effort to stop the disease from spreading. How should the issue be resolved? Can countries balance their need to protect the public from a killer disease with the rights of the individual patients? *Survival: The Deadly Combination* examines the impact that extremely drug resistant (XDR) is having on people and societies. It deals with some controversial approaches, such as quarantine, to dealing with the illness.
