Dr. Brouse is one of the founding faculty members of the Texas Tech University HSC School of Pharmacy Dallas Campus. She precepts the cardiology & critical care clerkships for pharmacy students and residents at the North Texas Veterans Administration Medical Center and teaches within the nutrition, drug review, case studies, and grand rounds courses at the school. Dr. Brouse is also the program director for the critical care specialty residency affiliated with both institutions. She received her PharmD degree from the University of Missouri-Kansas City and completed a pharmacy practice & critical care specialty residency at the University of Kentucky Medical Center. Dr. Brouse became a Board Certified Pharmacotherapy Specialist in 2000.
