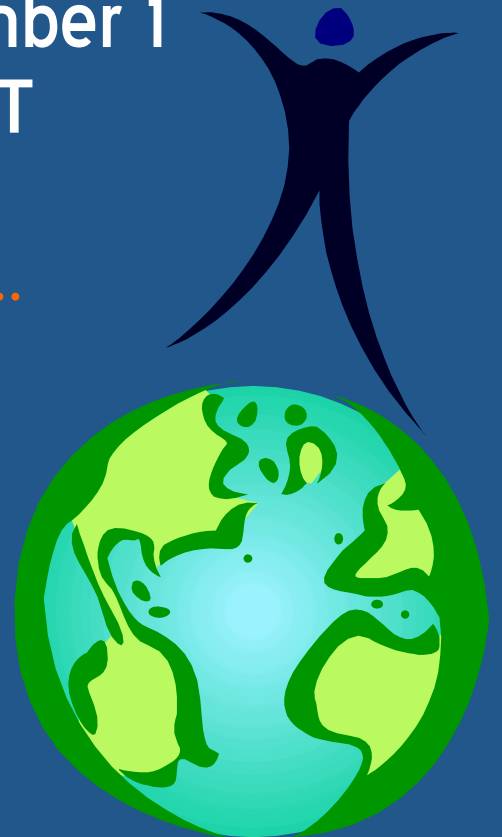

Illegal Immigration and Public Health

Immigrants are often uninsured or underinsured. Reportedly, forty-three percent of noncitizens under 65 have no health insurance. In addition, immigrants typically use the hospital and emergency services rather than preventative medical care. The cost of medical care for these uninsured immigrants strains the financial stability of the health care community. What can be done to provide medical care for illegal immigrants and reduce costs to the taxpayer, and what would be the most effective means of educating the immigrant population about preventative medical care? These questions will be addressed during this lecture.
