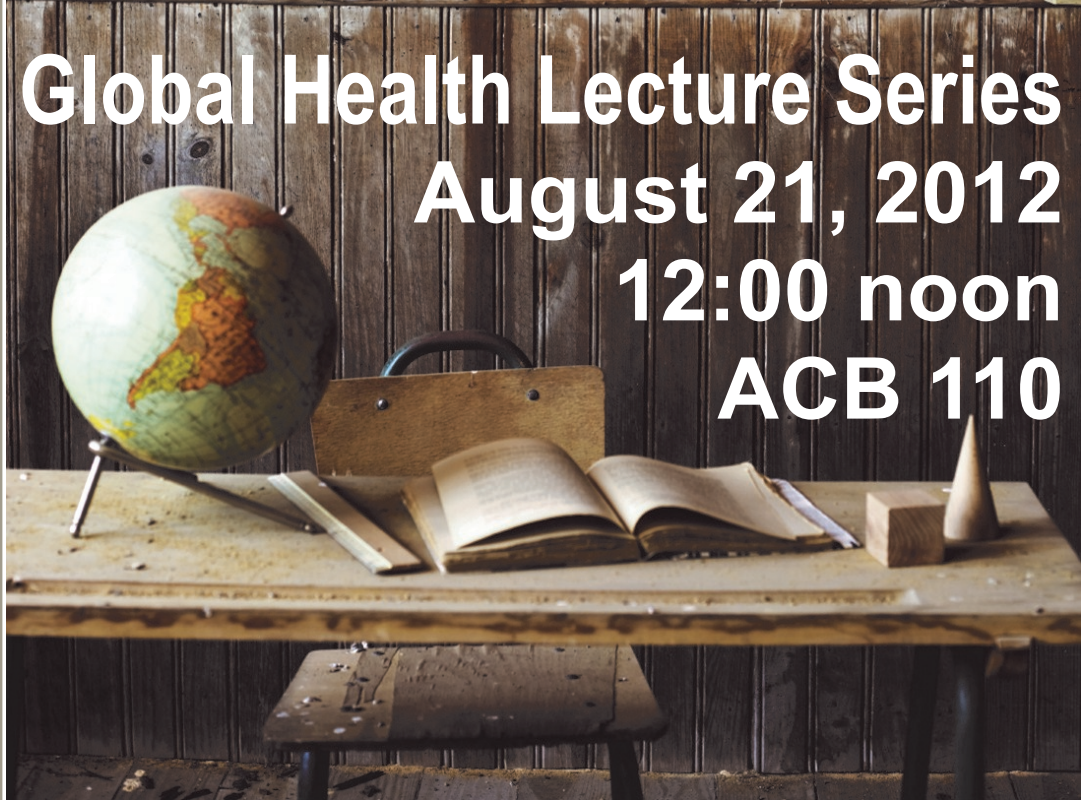

The Health Burden in the Developing World: Future Strategies

Devendra Gupta serves as the Vice Chancellor of King George Medical University located in Lucknow, India. This is one of the premier medical institutions in India. He also serves as the Director of the Super Specialty Hospitals in Noida and Greater Noida area and as the Professor and Head of the Department of Pediatric Surgery for the All India Institute of Medical Sciences in New Delhi.

Dr. Gupta has been involved in surgical care of children, postgraduate teaching, and research. His interests include childhood tumors, intersex disorders, biliary atresia, Hirschsprung's disease, neonatal gastric pullup, molecular biology, stem cell application, and pediatric surgery. Since January 1977, he has operated on more than 10,000 newborns and children with various malformations.

The recipient of numerous academic awards and recognitions, Dr. Gupta is a well published researcher and surgeon who has delivered lectures and presentations around the world. He will serve as president of the World Federation of Association of Pediatric Surgeons from 2014-2016.
