## Applications of Music in Medicine

Christine Neugebauer has 20 years experience as a music therapist working in pediatric healthcare. She is a clinical researcher, a national and international speaker, and has published articles on the applications of music therapy in pediatric burn care and general pediatrics. Currently, she is the Administrator of Child & Family Integrative Care at Covenant Children's Hospital where she is implementing a new Arts in Medicine program.
