Dr. Marjorie Jenkins joined TTUHSC in 2001 to build a women's health program in Amarillo, where she developed the women's health division and a women's health fellowship training program (one of 20 in the nation). In 2005, she was the catalyst in bringing a bilingual daylong Hispanic Women's Health Symposium to Amarillo- *Hablando de la Salud de la Mujer* and in 2007 she joined TTUHSC leaders in establishing a multi-campus women's health institute and established the *Laura W. Bush* Institute for Women's Health, a six-campus institute, where she serves as Executive Director. Dr. Jenkins is an invited guest speaker at the 2008 Business and Professional Leadership Summit in Washington, DC, chaired by Senator Kay Bailey Hutchison.
