Title: FAMILY PARTICIPATION IN PATIENT CARE DECISIONS	Policy Number: EP 6.9

Policy Statement:

It is the policy of the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center El Paso (TTUHSC El Paso) to respect patient wishes regarding the inclusion of family members and/or significant others in their care, education and treatment decisions.

Scope and Distribution:

This policy applies and will be distributed to all TTUHSC El Paso ambulatory clinics.

Procedure:

- 1. To the extent that the patient agrees and approves family and/or significant others may be contributors in obtaining patient history, participate in patient education, and be included in the development and implementation of patient treatment plans.
- 2. When family members or significant others participate in significant patient care decisions or instructions, documentation in the Medical Record should reflect his/her role.
- If the patient is incompetent to make decisions, the person legally authorized to make health-care decisions for the patient is responsible for determining the extent of family or significant other participation in the development and implementation of patient treatment plans.
