TTUHSC 2014-2015 INFLUENZA VACCINE DECLINATION FORM

Influenza is a viral infection that can cause mild to severe illness with complications that may lead to death. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimates that 36,000 to 40,000 people in the U. S. die from severe influenza-related complications each year.

The flu usually spreads from person to person in respiratory droplets when people who are infected cough or sneeze. People occasionally may become infected by touching something with influenza virus on it and touching their mouth, nose, or eyes. Healthy adults may be able to infect others one day before getting symptoms and up to five days after getting sick. Therefore, it is possible to give someone the flu before you know you are sick as well as while you are sick.

The CDC states that the Influenza Vaccine may be given during pregnancy; however we recommend you consult with your Primary Care Physician or Obstetrician prior to receiving the Influenza Vaccine.
