

# Ambulatory Clinic Policy and Procedure

Title: HEALTHCARE ASSOCIATED INFECTION REPORTING	Policy Number: EP 7.24

## **Policy Statement:**

It is the policy of the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center El Paso (TTUHSC El Paso) to track and report all healthcare associated infections.

## Scope and Distribution:

This policy applies and will be distributed to all Texas Tech Physicians of El Paso clinics.

### **Procedure:**

- 1. Upon discovery of a healthcare associated infection in a patient, the responsible person (designated by the clinic) should complete a Healthcare Associated Infection Communication Form (see attachment A), and forward the report to the infection control nurse or designee.
- The infection control nurse should use the CDC/NHSN Surveillance Definitions for Specific Types of Infections and/or Frequently Asked Questions About Surgical Site Infections as a guideline in determining whether the infection is healthcare associated or not. <u>https://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/PDFs/pscManual/17pscNosInfDef\_current.pdf</u>.
- 3. The infection control nurse or designee should investigate all reports and if appropriate, complete the Infection Control Surveillance Post-Operative Patient Form (see attachment B).
- 4. Forward positive findings and other pertinent information to the appropriate clinic/facility for follow up and/or further investigation.
