

RESIDENCY APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for your interest in the Internal Medicine Residency Training Program at the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center in El Paso. The program will be participating and accepting applications only through the Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS) through December 1st.

- 1. All documents should be submitted as required via ERAS.
- 2. This institution accepts:
 - a. US Graduates
 - b. US Citizens or Permanent Residents with Foreign Medical Education
 - c. Foreign Medical Graduates with J-1 Visas
 - d. 5th Pathway
- 3. For Foreign Medical Graduates (FMG's), U.S. Clinical experience is preferred, but not required.
- 4. CS Exam must be taken by November of the current year.
- 5. Selection of candidates for interview will be based on multiple factors as determined by the Internal Medicine Selection Committee.
- 6. Due to the large volume of applicants, we will only be able to communicate with candidates once they have been selected for an interview by the Candidate Selection Committee.
- Currently, the program and the Graduate Medical Education (GME) office will review and follow approval process for observerships as required by the GME Standard Policy and Procedures.
