Monthly exams are directly related to the resident's Medical Knowledge competency training. A monthly exam will be administered to all residents on the last Tuesday of every month from 7:30am to 8:30am (in lieu of morning report). Each exam is composed of 40 questions. Questions will be randomly selected by the Program Director every month.
