RESIDENCY PROGRAM - MONTHLY EXAM GUIDELINES

Monthly exams are MANDATORY! These exams are directly related to the resident's Medical Knowledge competency training. A monthly exam will be administered to all residents on the <u>second Wednesday</u> of every month from <u>12:00pm to 1:00pm</u>. Each exam is composed of 40 questions. Questions will be randomly selected by the Program Director every month. Passing score is 80% correct. The questions on the exams will come from the MKSAP 15th Edition.

MAKE-UP exams:

Make-up exams are **MANDATORY** and must be taken <u>within a week</u> of the monthly scheduled exam. Make-up exams are to be taken:

- ✓ if resident did not pass their scheduled exam
- ✓ if resident is Post-Call
- ✓ if resident is on Vacation
- ✓ if resident's Day Off is on the date of the Exam

If residents **DO NOT SHOW UP** for make-up exams, disciplinary policy process will be enforced.

- If resident does not show up for make-up exam, he/she will receive a Warning Letter.
- 2^{nd} No Show > Observation
- 3^{rd} No Show > Probation
